PURPOSE

To provide parents/carers and other members of our school community an understanding of the importance of having a school uniform policy and ensuring this policy is adhered to.

POLICY

It is compulsory for all students to wear the complete uniform whilst at the College, travelling to and from the College and when attending College functions and excursions as directed.

Wearing a school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride, connectedness and school spirit within the college.
- Enables students to be identified at all times (at and away from school ie. excursions) and maintains a safe and secure environment.
- Raises the image of the school and its students in the broader community.
- Helps reduce social and economic differences between students.
- Promotes structure and discipline among students.

The official Sunshine College uniform is:

- Sunshine College Blazer(Year 11-12)
- Sunshine College skirt or dress
- Sunshine College long grey uniform trousers or grey uniform shorts with white or black socks
- V- neck navy pullover with Sunshine College logo
- Sunshine College shirt(long or short sleeve)
- Navy, black or white Hijab
- Sunshine College tie (optional)
- Year 12 Jacket (optional)
- Black polished leather regulation school shoes

Sports and PE Uniform:

- School PE polo shirt with logo
- School/navy PE shorts
- School/navy PE
 tracksuit
- Sports shoes

Optional items

- Sunshine College blazer (Year7-10)
- Sunshine College scarf
- Sunshine College tie

Sunshine College Student Uniform Policy

This policy was developed in accordance with the guidelines set by the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development (DEECD).

- 1. Students are expected to wear the complete uniform and to present a neat appearance whilst at the College, travelling to and from the College and when attending College functions unless directed otherwise. The uniform must be clean and tidy in appearance and in good condition.
- 2. Black leather regulation school shoes must be worn at all times. Sneakers and other sports shoes may be worn during PE classes. School shoes must have flat heels. Boots, pointed shoes, suede shoes ballet flats and open toe footwear are not permitted.
- 3. Tattoos- must remain covered while at school
- 4. If hair is long, it may have to be tied back for practical classes.
- 5. Skivvies, hooded tops, colourful T-shirts, and leggings are not permitted to be worn under the school uniform.
- 6. Excessive make up is unsuitable for school and should not be worn.navy shorts, white socks and runners. (It is compulsory and part of HPE curriculum program)
- 7. School shirts must be worn appropriately at all times.
- 8. Students must always wear the complete school uniform. Students wearing inappropriate or offensive items of clothing will be asked to remove them. Students are not permitted to wear a combination of sport uniform and school uniform. (For example, school's sports polo top and school trousers)
- 9. Student who cannot have an item of uniform removed or replaced at the school may be sent home or removed from classrooms, the yard, incursions or excursions.
